# The beautiful exchange

## *What Adam lost, Jesus redeemed*

### Adam

- All became sinners (12)
- Judgement followed bringing condemnation (16/18)
- One man's disobedience brought death and defeat (17)
- Labelled sinner (19)
- Sin increased causing death (20/21)

### Jesus

- All who BELIEVED became righteous (17)
- Abundant grace followed bringing justification, acceptance & life (16/18)
- One man's obedience enable us to be victorious and reign in life (17)
- Declared righteous (19)
- Grace increased even more, reigning in life with Jesus (20/21)

*<sup>20</sup> The law was brought in so that the trespass (sin) might increase. **But where sin increased, grace increased all the more,** <sup>21</sup> so that, just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness to bring eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.*

***Romans 5v20-21***

***What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase? <sup>2</sup> By no means! We are those who have died to sin; how can we live in it any longer?***

**Romans 6-8: Dead TO sin**

**Romans 1-5: Dead IN sin**

*<sup>3</sup> Or don't you **know** that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? <sup>4</sup> We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, **just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.** <sup>5</sup> For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his. <sup>6</sup> For we **know** that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin— <sup>7</sup> because anyone who has died has been set free from sin.*

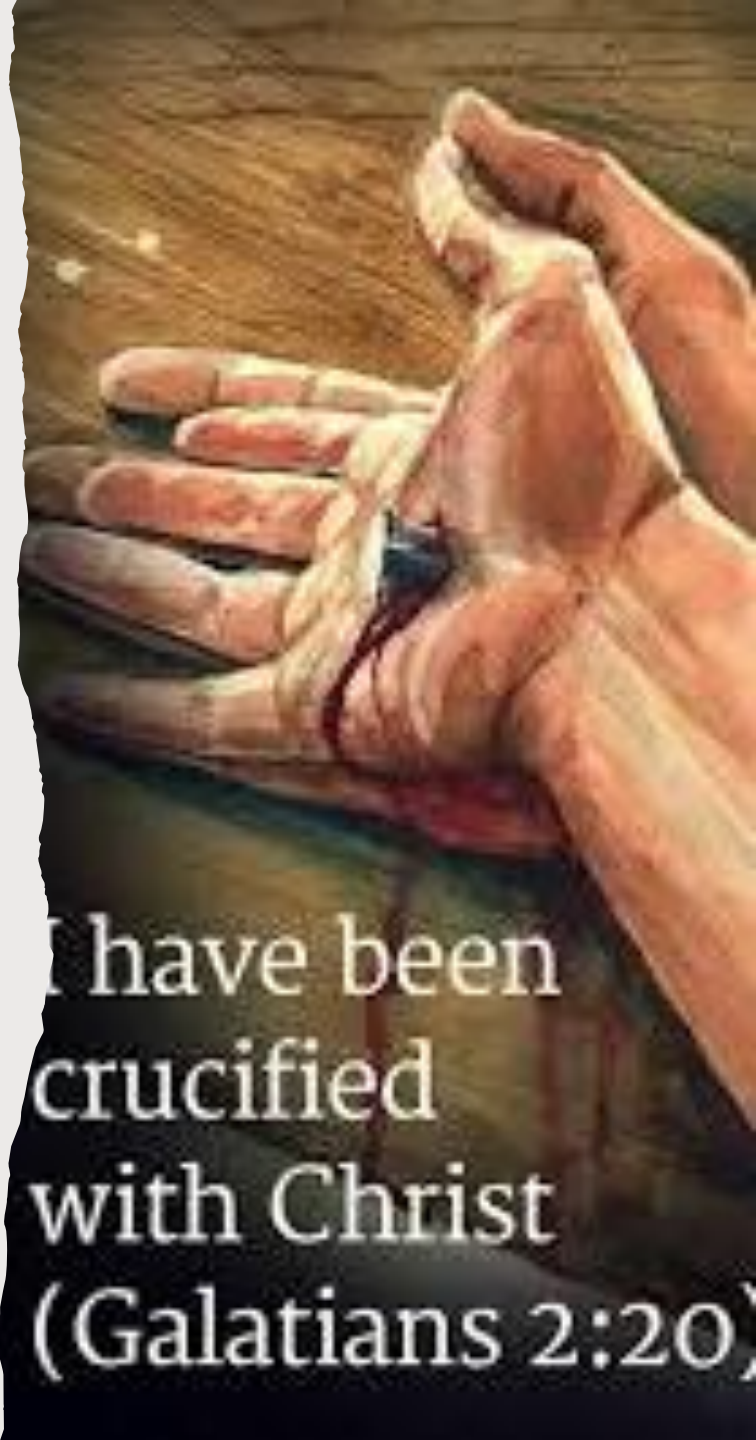

## **Victory over sin** ***Know – the truth***

Know that the day I trusted Jesus as my Saviour:

- I was justified and made whole and new in Jesus (My spirit was regenerated and made alive in Christ)
- My old self was crucified with Jesus (my sin nature was rendered powerless, useless, unimportant)
- My identity is no longer in my past but in who God truly created me to be

*<sup>8</sup> Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. <sup>9</sup> For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. <sup>10</sup> The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God. <sup>11</sup> In the same way, **count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus.***

# **Victory over sin**

## ***Count myself dead to sin***

**It is foolishness to live as though you in times of peace when you are in a battle and war zone**

- God Declares the truth and promises over you
- Satan always Denies the truth
- You DECIDE who and what you going to believe
  
- The old man or woman is rendered powerless unless you grant it power...
- Every time you wilfully sin against God, you give CPR to the old man or woman

***12** Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. **13** Do not offer any part of yourself to sin as an instrument of wickedness but **rather offer yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness.***
