As we seek to be and multiply disciples of Jesus we intentionally seek to be and become more and more like Jesus. We see from the Bible that everything He is and did is soaked in Scripture and following and empowered by the Holy Spirit. When Jesus prays to His Father, He is expectant that He will hear from Him and that His Father not only listens, but will answer. Jesus also, time and time again, chose to notice people and not be so focused on schedules or programmes that they were missed. We choose as a church to be like Jesus in these four values.

GATHERINGS AND MAKING DISCIPLES



This term we continue with two Sunday morning gatherings (8:45 and 10:30) with coffee served in between. We also have our Youth Service (Breathe) each Sunday evening.

If we are to see fully devoted disciples made and multiplied however, we recognise that attendance at a large gathering once a week is insufficient to fulfill that vision. Jesus made disciples in smaller communities rather than in the crowds.

In addition to our Life Groups, this term will see the launch of at least one micro-church and the preparation of others to lead intentional disciple making communities. At the beginning of 2023 we took the words of the Lord's Prayer as a focus verse for the year. The 'strapline' that we took was 'Growing outposts of Heaven here on earth'. In addition to prayerfully creating an 'outpost of Heaven' at the Hub we seek to do this in our workplaces, in our streets and in other places around our region.

At the **Hub on Tuesday evenings** we will be using some training from Zume to equip us in growing in these things. Some life groups may also be using this material as a follow on from 'The Discipleship Pathway'. Prayer and Fasting 15th-24th Sept 2023

Around the world between 15th -24th September followers of Jesus will be taking time to fast and pray, turning to God in repentance, worship and praise. YOUTH

We are passionate about seeing young people grow into all God has for them. We want to see the young people in our community thrive and flourish, regardless of their background or faith. We want them to know that they have purpose and so much potential for making a positive impact in the world, and this starts in Chalfont St Peter!

Over the next term we are going to continue to take time to speak to the young people about what will help their walks with Jesus. Because of this, some things may change format across the term – keep an eye on the website and communications to stay up to date. For this term our programme will look like this:

Breathe Youth Service

Sundays 6-8pm

Breathe is our youth gathering for school years 7-13, run and led by our young people during term time. We have lots of fun and games beginning with some basketball and some singing and someone 'sharing a thought' and then time to have a chat in discussion groups! From being part of the welcome or tech teams, to playing in our band or speaking... Come and join the fun- we would love to have you join us and hear what you think!

Mid-week Bible Study Tuesdays

Bible Studies will recommence, every other week, on Tuesday 3rd October at the Hub. The content of these groups will be discussed with the young people at the start of the term to create a space where we are exploring Gods word and responding to certain 'Hot Topics' that they want to cover.

On a Tuesday we will have a younger youth Bible study (Year 7-10) from 5:30pm – 6:30pm. After this we will have dinner together and the older youth will join. Older youth (Year 11-13) will then have their Bible Study from 7:30pm-8:30pm.









5th-11th February 2024
