How it Works

Every Wednesday we will post up a small pack that we pray will help you in engaging with the Bible at home, especially during times such as these.

Each pack will include:

Bible Passage:

This will include the passage that the rest of the pack will be looking at as well as some other ways of presenting and sharing stories from the Bible with children.

Age Appropriate Study/Reflections:

This will provide some resource to help children engage with the passage they have read previously. It will vary each week and include different activities and questions appropriate to their ages. With the younger age groups adults will need to help them with explaining the activities.

Prayer Time:

A written prayer or prayer activity to do as a family or encourage your children to do it themselves.

Extra Bits:

At the back there will be a colouring sheet and one extra activity such as a word search.

Take Some Time Together:

We would love to encourage you to take this opportunity to spend time together around the Bible. You may find that what is in this pack leads you onto another conversation.

Bible Story

Mark 2:1-12 New International Verson (NIV) Jesus Heals the Paralysed Man

A few days later, when Jesus again entered Capernaum, the people heard that he had come home. ²They gathered in such large numbers that there was no room left, not even outside the door, and he preached the word to them. ³Some men came, bringing to him a paralyzed man, carried by four of them. ⁴Since they could not get him to Jesus because of the crowd, they made an opening in the roof above Jesus by digging through it and then lowered the mat the man was lying on. ⁵When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralyzed man, "Son, your sins are forgiven."

- ⁶ Now some teachers of the law were sitting there, thinking to themselves, ⁷ "Why does this fellow talk like that? He's blaspheming! Who can forgive sins but God alone?"
- ⁸ Immediately Jesus knew in his spirit that this was what they were thinking in their hearts, and he said to them, "Why are you thinking these things? ⁹ Which is easier: to say to this paralyzed man, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Get up, take your mat and walk'? ¹⁰ But I want you to know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins." So he said to the man, ¹¹ "I tell you, get up, take your mat and go home." ¹² He got up, took his mat and walked out in full view of them all. This amazed everyone and they praised God, saying, "We have never seen anything like this!"

Where did the man in our Bible story go?




When the paralysed man was taken to Jesus, Jesus made him better! How amazing is that!



Question:

What two things did Jesus do?

Activity:

When the paralysed man met Jesus, Jesus forgave him and healed him! How amazing is that. At the moment, there are lots of people in our world who are sick. We should pray for them!

You will need: 2 pieces of paper (different colours if you can!), some pens, a pair of scissors and 2 plasters.

- Draw around your hand and cut it out.
- Stick it onto the other piece of paper.
- Stick the plasters on the hand in a cross shape.
- Write at the top "Jesus is the healer"
- Around the hand you could write the names of people or some prayers.

Put this somewhere where you can see it to remind you that Jesus is the healer and also to pray.
