



## ***What will I be involved in?***

As part of the Gold Hill Volunteer Intern Programme you will be asked to specialise in one major ministry area, which would be discussed and agreed prior to beginning the internship. Additionally, there would be some opportunities to explore other areas, like those below:

- **Youth** - *be actively involved in leading both church-based and community youth groups.*
- **Mission, Evangelism and Discipleship** – *support the local church in reaching the community. Be proactive in leading initiatives and courses to all ages, sharing the Good News of Jesus in word and action.*
- **Web & Digital Media** – *help get our message out to the world by shaping our website and introducing other new and fresh ways of communication.*
- **Worship** – *actively support our music and teaching team in all aspects of corporate worship and service preparation.*
- **Support ministry** – *support of church leaders and partnerships.*

## ***What will I receive as a volunteer intern?***

- **Accommodation** – *you will be provided with full board and lodging with a local church family.*
- **Training** - *will include theological and practical training, and be rooted in prayer, worship and the growth of your personal relationship with God. In addition you will be a full part of the staff team and will attend all staff meetings and retreat days.*
- **Mentoring & management** – *you will have a clear structure of management and mentoring for your practical needs and for your personal development.*
- **Pocket Money** – *a small weekly allowance of £50 will be provided but you are also encouraged to get support from your sending church where possible.*
- **Expenses** – *agreed and relating to your role as an intern will be reimbursed.*
- **Hours & Time off** – *Interns will have a full work schedule but will have at least one full day off each week; precise hours & specific days off to be agreed on appointment.*
- **Holidays** – *will be agreed with your line manager with interns having 18 days away from the placement, and in addition the break between Christmas and New Year.*
- **Supported** – *you will be valued as part of the church family and will be given many opportunities to develop your gifting and skills as you serve the local and wider church.*
